



Selection of Visiting Professor Scholarship Candidates in Brazil under the Institutional Internationalization Program - CAPES - PrInt

Internal Selection Process - 04/24/2020

1. PREAMBLE

1.1. The deliberative commission of the Graduate Program in Food Science (PPGCAL) of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRJ), in the use of its attributions set out in article 5, paragraph 1, item III of the general regulation of graduate studies stricto sensu of UFRJ (Attachment to CEPG Resolution No. 1 of December 1, 2006) and in article 12, item I of the regulation of postgraduate stricto sensu of graduate and research commissions and of deliberative commissions of postgraduate programs undergraduate course at UFRJ (Attachment to CEPG Resolution No. 2 of December 2, 2006), makes public to the interested parties that will be open, in the coordination of PPGCAL, in the period from 27/04/2020 to 15/05/2020 the registrations for the selection process of applicants for the Visiting Professor scholarship in Brazil under the Institutional Internationalization Program (PrInt) / CAPES, effective between October and December 2020.

1.2. This notice was approved by the PPGCAL deliberative committee, at an ordinary meeting held on 04/24/2020, and is in compliance with Notice 41/2017 - CAPES / PrInt and with CAPES Ordinance No. 289, of December 28, 2018.

2. REGISTRATION

2.1. Registration for the selection process to compete for the Doctorate Sandwich scholarship abroad under the scope of PrInt / CAPES will be open from 4/27/2020 to 5/15/2020.

2.2. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the consequent interruption of face-to-face activities at UFRJ, enrollments will exceptionally occur electronically. All documents must be sent to the following e-mails: ppgcal@iq.ufrj.br **AND** spg@iq.ufrj.br **AND** danielperrone@iq.ufrj.br.

2.3. Teachers and / or researchers with recognized and proven academic and scientific experience, active and resident abroad and who are active in their area of training may apply for the Visiting Professor in Brazil.

2.4. The candidate must fulfill the following requirements when registering:

1. Hold a doctoral degree.
2. Act effectively abroad as a teacher and / or researcher.
3. Applications from professors who are teaching or research activities in Brazil will not be accepted.

2.5. The following documents are required for registration:

1. Document certifying residency and link with a teaching and / or research institution abroad.
2. Updated curriculum vitae.



3. ORCID record updated. The ORCID record provides a unique identifier for the academic and research fields. Registration is free and can be done at <https://orcid.org/>.
4. Work plan, with a maximum of 5 pages, to be developed during the stay in Brazil, containing the following items:
 - a. The activities to be developed (courses, training, lectures or seminars);
 - b. Justification, presenting the timeliness and relevance of the theme of the activities, its adherence to the Institutional Project for Internationalization at UFRJ and, if applicable, also to the project in international cooperation;
 - c. Clear definition and delimitation of the study object (s) to be approached in the activities;
 - d. Goals and objectives;
 - e. Schedule of activities.

3. SCHOLARSHIPS

- 3.1. The PPGCAL has 1 (one) quota for a Visiting Professor scholarship in Brazil, of 15 (fifteen) days, effective between October and December 2020.
- 3.2. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the consequent uncertainty about activities abroad, the PPGCAL will authorize those contemplated in this call to make possible changes in the validity of the scholarships, as long as previously authorized by CAPES.
- 3.3. Those selected will be entitled to the monthly fee, travel allowance (return ticket to the place of the destination institution), installation assistance and health insurance, according to Annex XI of the Notice 41/2017 of CAPES, available on the website PR-2 / UFRJ at the following link: http://app.pr2.ufrj.br/public/uploads/repositories/VALORES_BOLSAS_NO_PAIS.pdf.
- 3.4. At least 70% (seventy percent) of the total resources made available to PPGCAL under PrInt / CAPES must be invested in the priority countries (highlighted in green in Annex 1) and a maximum of 30% (thirty percent) in the other countries (highlighted in in Appendix 1). Countries not listed in Annex 1 are not included in this notice.

4. SELECTION PROCESS

- 4.1. The selection of candidates will be conducted by a temporary committee, specifically defined by the Deliberative Commission of the PPGCAL for this purpose, with a member of the permanent faculty of the PPGCAL (excluding advisors and co-advisors of candidates enrolled in this selection process), two members students and a student representative.
- 4.2. The criteria adopted for the selection of fellows will be:
 1. meeting the requirements by the candidate.
 2. adequacy of the documentation submitted by the candidate;
 3. candidate's curriculum vitae;
 4. scientific-academic merit of the plan and its adherence to the theme of the Institutional Project for Internationalization
- 4.3. The partial result will be released on 05/25/2020 and, after a period for filing appeals, the final result will be released on 05/27/2020, by e-mail to the entire PPGCAL community, on the Facebook page and on the PPGCAL website (www.ppgcal.iq.ufrj.br).

5. RESOURCES



- 5.1. The deadline for filing appeals will be 48 working hours, in any case, after publication of the preliminary result, with the initial date and time of its disclosure.
- 5.2. The appeal must be individual, with the precise indication of what the candidate considers to be harmed, and duly substantiated; the candidate must prove the allegations and, whenever possible, attach copies of the proofs.
- 5.3. The application must be typed, using A4 sheets, containing the candidate's name and must be sent by e-mail to the coordination (ppgcal@iq.ufrj.br AND spg@iq.ufrj.br AND danielperrone@iq.ufrj.br).

6. FINAL PROVISIONS

- 6.1. Any rule provided for in this Notice may be changed, at any time, prior to selection, by re-publishing the item or items eventually rectified, altered or supplemented;
- 6.2. Omitted cases will be resolved by the Selection Committee heard, whenever possible, by the Legal Attorney of UFRJ.
