

SCHOLARSHIPS ABROAD CALL FOR PROPOSALS OF SELECTION OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO THE INSTITUTIONAL PROGRAM OF INTERNATIONALIZATION - Capes-Print, IN THE CIVIL ENGINEERING PROGRAM (PEC) OF THE ALBERTO LUIZ COIMBRA INSTITUTE OF GRADUATE STUDIES AND ENGINEERING RESEARCH (COPPE) OF THE FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF RIO DE JANEIRO (UFRJ).

the Civil Engineering Program (PEC) of COPPE / UFRJ makes public the call for proposals of selection of scholarships for the Institutional Program of Internationalization - Capes-Print, in accordance with Edict 41/2017-Capes / Print and Regulation Capes No. 289 of December 28, 2018.

Scholarships and Missions offered by PEC/COPPE/UFRJ under the Capes Print Notice for the Third Window of 2022:

The Civil Engineering Program is offering the following modalities of scholarships:

SCHOLARSHIPS IN BRAZIL

- 1 Postdoctoral scholarship with experience abroad - 12 months;
- 1 Visiting teacher scholarship in Brazil - 1 month.

SCHOLARSHIPS ABROAD

- 1 Sandwich Doctorate scholarship – 12 months;
- 1 Senior visiting teacher scholarship – 3 months.

MISSION ABROAD

- 1 Scholarship mission abroad.

Scholarships provided by the Dean of Graduate Studies and Research - PR2/UFRJ

In addition to the scholarships listed above, offered by the CAPES-Print project of the PPG PEC/COPPE-UFRJ, there will be others, made available by the Dean of Research – PR2, if there is a budgetary resource that allows the transformation into scholarships with CAPES. These will be

offered in the form of “wait list” model. The granting of scholarships to candidates on the waiting list will be coordinated by PR2, considering the total number of candidates from UFRJ. Therefore, in case of demand greater than the surplus of resources, PR2 will use as tie-breaking criteria:

a. Balance in the proportion of priority and non-priority countries: applications that involve partnership with countries that appear on the list present in Annex I of Call 41/2017 CAPES-Print will be ranked before those that do not involve such countries (cf ANNEX 2 and https://app.pr2.ufrj.br/public/uploads/repositories/Esclarecimentos_Paises_Parceiros_PrInt_29Out19final.pdf)

b. Difficulty in allocating CAPES-Print resources throughout the year: applications from graduate programs that have had surplus funds for grants after the nomination window closes will have priority over those who have already used all the resources allocated to them at the time the composition of the UFRJ Institutional Internationalization Plan budget;

c. Number of doctoral students: applications from graduate programs with more doctoral students will have priority over those with fewer students.

Those candidates approved will be contacted by the PPG and PR2 secretariat according to their classification to present the necessary complementary documentation to start the processes via SEI. If there is no budget forecast for new vacancies, the waiting list will lose its validity at the end of 2022.

Selection criteria by modality

Candidates who submit all documentation and meet the requirements listed in the Capes Print Notice and the "PR2 Guidelines" will be considered fit and classified according to the following criteria:

- Sandwich Doctoral Scholarships: Academic performance and Scientific Production considering the same weights currently used for the distribution of doctoral scholarships;
- Postdoctoral Scholarship with experience abroad: Academic performance and Scientific Production considering the same weights for the distribution of PNPd scholarships;
- 3-month scholarship for senior pec professor conduct internship abroad: Number of articles indexed in jcr in the last 5 years;
- Visiting professor from abroad for 1 month in Brazil: Number of articles indexed in the JCR authored by the candidate in the last 5 years;
- Missions abroad for teachers: Number of articles indexed in jcr in the last 5 years;

For all modalities, eligible countries of origin (scholarships in Brazil) or destination (overseas scholarships) are:

South Africa | Germany | Angola | Argentina | Australia | Austria | Belgium | Canada | Chile | China | Colombia | South Korea | Cuba | Denmark | Spain | United States | France | Greece | Netherlands | India | Indonesia | Ireland | Italy | Japan | Mexico | Mozambique | Norway | Peru | Portugal | United Kingdom | Russia | Sweden | Switzerland | Uruguay



Of these, those marked in green are priority according to Annex I of the Capes-PrInt notice. The SGP reserves the right to refuse applications for non-priority countries so as not to exceed the amount of resources for these countries (30%).

Theme: Sustainability, Growth and Combating Inequalities

The project must be related to the theme "Sustainability, Growth and Combating Inequalities", whose summary is presented below:

The growth of societies will only result in sustainable socioeconomic development if it is articulated to combating inequalities. Thus, research is needed to develop techniques and products, propose theoretical analyses and critical discussions on growth in their different dimensions - economic, demographic, technological, urban, educational - and that seek inequalities, result from the processes of exploitation of natural resources, whether social, political or legal engendered in today's society. We understand that these processes result in forms of social, racial, ethnic, economic, religious, orientation and sexual identity, gender, etc., which manifest themselves in institutions, power relations, policies, norms and rights, which stimulate or combat, in many aspects, both growth and inequalities. Such investigations and actions, developed in the various fields of knowledge, respond to Brazilian demands and that of different countries, and aim to foster the production of knowledge that collaborates in coping with these problems, as well as the construction of networks international, multi and interdisciplinary research, which give visibility to research developed at UFRJ and its partners on such issues.
